

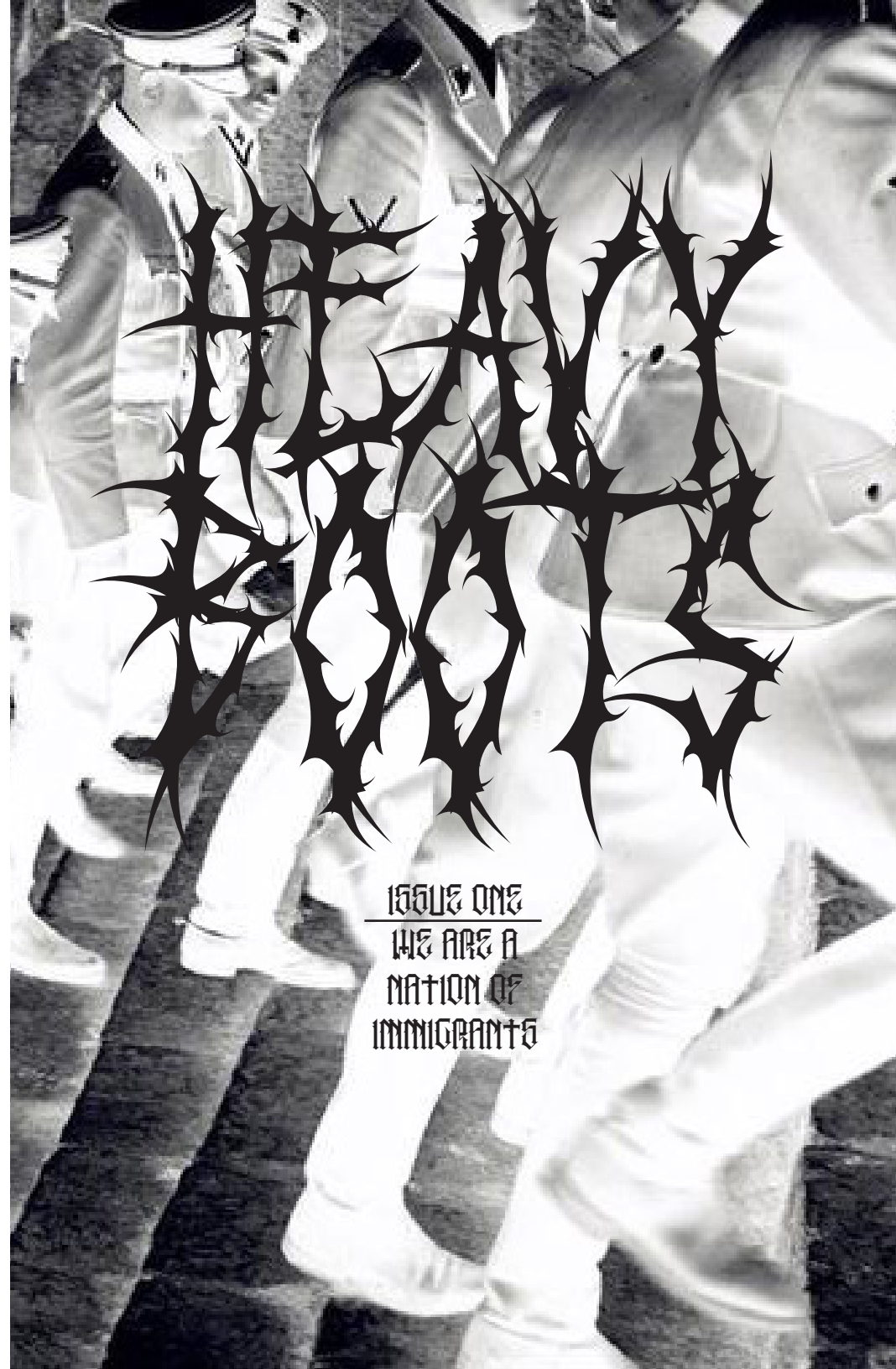
HOW TO USE THIS ZINE TO PROTECT IMMIGRANT FAMILIES IN YOUR COMMUNITY

- 1) Make paper copies if you want to distribute it or visit www.heavybootszine.com for a free printable pdf.
- 2) Pull out middle page and give it to anyone you know who might be at risk for arrest or deportation; tape it in a public bathroom stall in diverse neighborhoods; leave it in a community location.
- 3) Tear off this back cover (see other side) and give to a teacher or employer who is down with the cause.
- 4) Read and remember your rights as an ALLY, inside front cover. STAY AWARE. STAY SAFE. NOTICE. WITNESS. RECORD.

WHAT CAN WE ALL DO TO HELP?

1) KNOW AND SHARE THE RIGHTS OF UNDOCUMENTED IMMIGRANTS.

KEY POINTS ARE: DON'T SAY ANYTHING AND DON'T SIGN ANYTHING! THEY CANNOT DEPORT WITHOUT EVIDENCE.

Includes: Family Safety Plan. What to do if ICE confronts you on the street, at your door, is in your home, or a car stop. Common ICE ruses & lies;

& how to stay safe when documenting ICE raids.

2) EQUIP THOSE AT RISK TO EXERCISE THEIR RIGHTS

The middle section of this zine can be given to people in immigrant communities to connect them with info & help. The pocket cards can be given freely; follow the QR code on p.5 to print more in the language of your choice.

3) RECORD AND REPORT VERIFIED RAIDS OR ABUSE

ONLY REPORT RAIDS YOU HAVE SEEN FIRST HAND. DO NOT SPREAD RUMORS. THIS CAUSES PANIC AND INTERFERES WITH PEOPLES JOBS AND LIVES.

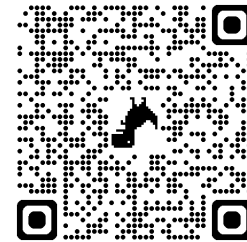

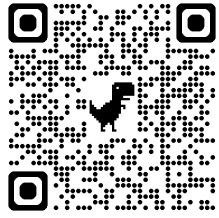

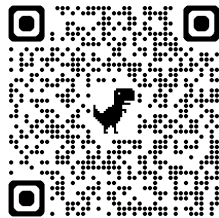
- **A Family Preparedness Plan helps you gather important information.**

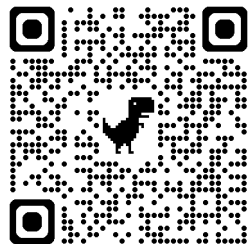

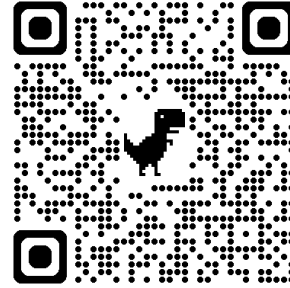

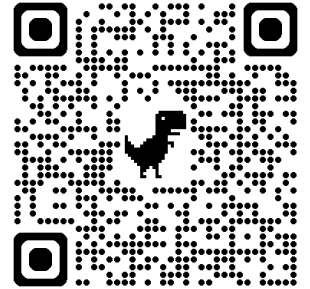
You Have the right to remain SILENT
(in some states you must give your name first.) **Do not say where you were born or how you got here. Do not SIGN any-**

thing without an attorney present. You have the right to an attorney. DO NOT RUN. DO NOT LIE. Lying or running can be used against you. Something you sign can be used to deport you.

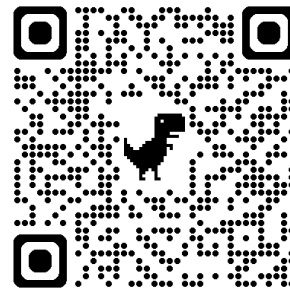

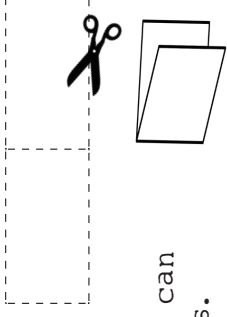

These cards can be distributed to community members and can be carried and used if confronted by immigration officers.



귀하에게는 헌법이 부여한 권리가 있습니다.

- 이민국 요원이 문을 두드릴 경우 문을 열어주지 마십시오.
- 이민국 요원이 질문을 할 때 어떤 질문에든 대답하지 마십시오. 귀하에게는 묵비권을 행사할 권리가 있습니다.
- 변호사와 만나기 전에는 어떠한 서명도 하지 마십시오. 귀하에게는 변호사와 상담할 권리가 있습니다.
- 집밖에 있을 경우, 이민국 요원에게 귀하가 그 자리를 떠날 수 있는 자유가 있는지 여부를 묻고 이민국 요원이 '예'라고 답변을 한다면 침착하게 자리를 떠나십시오.
- 이 카드를 이민국 요원에게 주십시오. 만약 귀하가 집안에 머물고 있다면, 이 카드를 창문이나 문 아래로 밀어 넣어 전달하십시오.

Usted tiene derechos constitucionales:

- **NO ABRA LA PUERTA** si un agente de inmigración está tocando la puerta.
- **NO CONTESTE NINGUNA PREGUNTA** de un agente de inmigración si trata de hablar con usted. Usted tiene el derecho a guardar silencio.
- **NO FIRME NADA** sin antes hablar con un abogado. Usted tiene el derecho de hablar con un abogado.
- Si usted está fuera de su casa, pregúntele al agente si tiene la libertad de irse y si le dice que sí, váyase con tranquilidad.
- **ENTRÉGUELE ESTA TARJETA EL AGENTE.** Si usted está dentro de su casa, muestre la tarjeta por la ventana o pásela debajo de la puerta.

لديك حقوق دستورية:

- لا تفتح الباب إذا كان شرطي الهجرة يطرق عليك. لديك الحق في التزام الصمت.
- لا تجيب على أي أسئلة يسئلها شرطة الهجرة إذا حاولوا التحدث إليك. لديك الحق في التحدث إلى محامي.
- إذا كنت خارج بيتك، اسأل الشرطي إذا كان لديك حرية العبادة، وإذا قال نعم، غادر بهدوء.
- أعطني هذه البطاقة للشرطي. إذا كنت داخل منزلك، اعرض البطاقة من خلال النافذة أو مررها من تحت الباب.

You have constitutional rights:

- **DO NOT OPEN THE DOOR** if an immigration agent is knocking on the door.
- **DO NOT ANSWER ANY QUESTIONS** from an immigration agent if they try to talk to you. You have the right to remain silent.
- **DO NOT SIGN ANYTHING** without first speaking to a lawyer. You have the right to speak with a lawyer.
- If you are outside of your home, ask the agent if you are free to leave and if they say yes, leave calmly.
- **GIVE THIS CARD TO THE AGENT.** If you are inside of your home, show the card through the window or slide it under the door.
